The Master Plan for the American Museum of Western Art was undertaken to facilitate a new museum devoted to a collection of art of Western American content. The proposed site for the new museum is situated in historic downtown Cartersville. Located within close proximity to Atlanta, Cartersville is situated on a highly traveled route through Northwest Georgia passing through towns rich with American history and culture. The new 66,000 square foot museum will incorporate a 250 person fully equipped auditorium, an educational center, research library and dining facilities. The museum will serve the surrounding community and will provide an understanding of the history of the West to the local community, visiting students and tourists.
