

## **Restaurant and Banquet Facility**

Referred to as Tavern on the Green (TOG) is one of the most recognized restaurants in the world and is one of the most beloved features of Central Park. As architects, we will perform the most significant restoration and renovation of the building since its original transformation from sheepfold to restaurant. With this restoration TOG will regain the status as a special urban retreat for all New Yorkers and visitors alike. A few major capital improvements are necessary: complete restoration of existing building, upgrading existing landscape, new HVAC, plumbing and electrical systems, new state-of-the-art kitchen within the current structure, and a new two story addition that will provide additional operating space. One of the most significant changes to the exterior appearance of TOG is the replacement of the Crystal Room with a new Conservatory.
