

Originally designed as a folly in Central Park, the planning, restoration and redesign of the Belvedere Castle, was undertaken to meet the needs of a visitors information center and admin-istrative offices for park rangers and maintenance staff. Work included the transformation of the basement into a functional office environment incor-porating an ADA compliant bathroom, locker area and sufficient storage space. Additional work included the radon removal system and a complete upgrade of the HVAC, the electrical system. Our work also included the restoration of the exterior facade and roof terraces.
